Before or after school care: \$15 per hour

Before school care runs from 7:00 - 8:15 am each morning.

After-school care runs from 3:30 – 5:30 pm each afternoon.

Lunch Service: Volunteer

Service begins at 11:45 am and runs until 12:30 pm. Usually, about 15 minutes of prep is all that's needed. Lunches come from the public school hot and ready to serve.

School Cleaners (\$150 per week – paid by families)

The average cleaning time is around 2 hours after school, Monday through Friday. Grab a few weeks or the majority. Contact the office if you would like to be on the schedule. A volunteer to schedule and make sure payments come in is always appreciated.

Last Week's Offerings

In thankfulness to God, we generously returned the following to the Lord: Current - \$13,629 (\$42 plate); Missions - \$1,106.50; Improvement - \$125; Mortgage - \$2,855.75; Devotional Booklets - \$2; Preschool Tuition - \$287; Extended Care - \$25.25; Worship at the Cross - \$17.50; Altar Fund - \$10; Audio/Visual - \$27; WLA Tuition Assistance - \$50; Hand Chime Fund - \$20; St. Paul's student Aid Fund - \$30; Electronic funds included in these gifts - \$3,664.25; all offerings totaled \$18,185.
