## What is a "Close Contact"?

As currently defined by Fond du Lac County Health

A "Close Contact" is anyone who has had more than 15 minutes of accumulated contact time within 6 feet of an individual.

Such a person should remain in quarantine for 14 days since last contact.

However, someone in contact with that individual (the close contact) is not a "close contact" themselves unless the close contact should become a positive carrier.

# I don't feel well and it might be COVID.

It's never bad to ask your physician. Follow their advice keep in contact. For testing contact your physician or the COVID Clinic at 844-225-0147.

#### **Tested Negative**




Continue with your Close contact quarantine as before.

#### I'm Not Testing



Continue with your Close Contact quarantine as before.

Timetables for return to school are 10 days after current symptoms pass or conclusion of previous quarantine, whichever is longer.

Let the school know so that we can help minimize spread.
