Hopefully we are learning many enduring lessons about spiritual maturity and godly patience with each passing day. Here's what the Lord says through James: "Consider it pure joy, my brothers and sisters, whenever you face trials of many kinds, because you know that the testing of your faith develops perseverance. Perseverance must finish its work so that you may be mature and complete, not lacking anything" (James 1:2-4).
