Last Week’s Offerings

In thankfulness to God, we returned the following to the Lord: Current - \$19,488.14 (\$1,169 plate); Missions - \$1,024.67; Improvement - \$70; Mortgage - \$7,175.30; Initial Offering - \$50; Lenten Envelopes - \$47; Maundy Thursday - \$1,568; Good Friday - \$3,301; Easter - \$7,083; MLC Matching - \$305 (out of \$4,800 goal); Easter Breakfast - \$402; Preschool Tuition - \$345; Alliant Match - \$1,000; Extended Care - \$426.25; Worship at the Cross - \$15; Altar Fund - \$10; Electronic funds included in these gifts - \$6,099.11; all offerings totaled \$42,310.36.
