Lutheran elementary school students are invited to attend as well. (We use two different curricula: *Christ Light* at school and *Growing in Christ* in Sunday school.)

St. Paul's Lutheran School will begin the 2017-18 school year on Wednesday, August 23rd, 8:30am (opening worship will be shortly thereafter). A parent orientation meeting will be held this coming Wednesday, Aug. 16th, at 6:00pm. Each family should have at least one parent attend. Students receive nine months of a high-quality, Christian education for the registration costs of \$490. The benefits, of course, are eternal. (Non-member annual tuition is \$1,300 [plus fees], but actual education costs exceed \$4,000 per student.)

Today's Sermon Text (*Leviticus 4:32-35*): "If he brings a lamb as his sin offering, he is to bring a female without defect. ³³ He is to lay his hand on its head and slaughter it for a sin offering at the place where the burnt offering is slaughtered. ³⁴ Then the priest shall take some of the blood of the sin offering with his finger and put it on the horns of the altar of burnt offering and pour out the rest of the blood at the base of the altar. ³⁵ He shall remove all the fat, just as the fat is removed from the lamb of the fellowship offering, and the priest shall burn it on the altar on top of the offerings made to the LORD by fire. In this way the priest will make atonement for him for the sin he has committed, and he will be forgiven."
