The "*Giving Plus*" app is being retired at the end of September. In its place, Vanco is offering "*Vanco Mobile*". It should be available in your phone's app store. You may need to search for "North Fond du Lac" or "Fond du Lac" to find the church or the school accounts. To make sure that the apps don't double-dip during the transition, please cancel payment in Giving+ as you transition to Vanco Mobile and restart your offerings/tuition in the new app. Remember, the Church account is for Offerings and the School account is for Tuition.
