Last Week's Offerings

God's people joyfully brought the following gifts to their Lord: Current Fund - \$10,570.24; Missions - \$272; Improvement Fund - \$70; Mortgage Fund - \$978; Audio/Visual Ministry - \$5; St. Paul's Student Aid Fund - \$100; (Electronic funds included in these gifts - \$1496.24; all offerings totaled \$11,995.24; weekly budgeted target \$17,000). 251 people attended worship in-person (44,67,140).
