
Matching Opportunity Exceeded!

Last Week's Offerings

God's people presented the following gifts to their Lord: Current - \$16,512.70; Missions - \$473.50; Improvement - \$90; Mortgage - \$1,813.75; Christmas Eve Envelopes - \$3,778.01; Christmas Day Envelopes - \$3,947; Poinsettias - \$755; Deficit Reduction - \$45,120 (includes \$25,000 match); Worship at the Cross - \$24.05; Audio/Visual - \$25; St. Paul's Student Aid \$20 (Electronic funds included in these gifts - \$2,252.88; all offerings totaled \$72,559.01; Weekly Budgeted Target \$18,960). 114 people attended weekend services (45, 65 [livestream - 35]). 397 attended the Christmas Eve Services (325, 72 [livestream - 51]) and 150 attended the Christmas Day Service [livestream - 69].
