As we continued our Lenten journey focused on the grace of our Father, we presented the following thank offerings: Current – \$9,015.37; Missions – \$742.27; Improvement – \$105; Mortgage – \$953; Lenten Envelopes – \$1,286; Easter Envelopes - \$20; Worship at the Cross – \$10; Preschool Tuition - \$444; Extended Care - \$332.75; Payroll Tax Refund – \$3006.66; Facilities Usage – \$150; Audio/Visual Fund – \$20; WLA Tuition Assistance Fund – \$100 (Electronic funds included in these gifts - \$2,865.39; all offerings totaled \$16,185.05; Weekly target \$17,063). 174 people attended Midweek Lenten Services (124, 50, livestream = 33) 318 people attended regular weekend services (58, 54, 206, livestream = 55).
