Last Week's Offerings:

As we continued our Lenten journey focused on the grace of our Father, we presented the following thank offerings: Current – \$9,484.72; Missions – \$858.30; Improvement – \$65; Mortgage – \$2,429.83; Devotional Booklets – \$10; Lenten Envelopes – \$1,031; Preschool Tuition - \$877; Easter Flowers - \$1,158; Extended Care - \$713.75; Altar Fund – \$20; Audio/Visual Fund – \$28; Organ/Piano – \$50 (Electronic funds included in these gifts – \$1641.22; all offerings totaled \$16,320.47; Weekly target \$18,960). 110 people attended Midweek Lenten Services (32,78 livestream = 24) 366 people attended regular weekend services (64,69,233 livestream = 53). Memorials were given to the Mortgage Fund in loving memory of Don Lane (Nathan Lane's Dad) who was called home to Jesus on March 14, 2019 and to the Altar Fund in loving memory of Edith Hinn who opened her eyes to the glories of heaven on March 27, 2023.
