# God's Word this week: Epiphany 3

Jesus shows His glory in the kind of people that He calls to serve Him and in using the Gospel to make them willing to follow Him. This week, it is the Epistle Lesson that gives unity to the readings. All of the other readings deal with specific full time calls that leave behind secular vocations. Jesus still calls such to the holy ministry. To all however comes the call to follow Him with a willingness to abandon everything should faithfulness require it; the calls in these readings bid us have a mindset which forsakes all and places Him first.

## **News from our January Voters Meeting:**

The budget has been set for the year. All budgetary items totaled = \$872,025.14 (\$16,721.48 per week). That's a 2% increase over last year. To put that in perspective, if all 765 communicant members gave \$22 per week, we would make our budget. Copies of the agenda are on the narthex information centers. The voters also extended a Divine call to Pastor Jonathan Bauer, currently serving Good News Lutheran in Mt. Horeb, WI. He and his wife, Lindsay, have three children. # Some Coming Changes to our COVID protocols in February

We will continually evaluate these changes as we move forward.

- *Sign-Ups*: We are the last WELS church in our area requiring worship signups. Our services have not been hitting their limits and a little over ½ of those in attendance each week used the sign-up model. With this in mind, we will continue our sign-ups through January and *in February suspend our signups* to see how things go.
- *Hymnals*: A number of members have requested hymnals. We will have hymnals available at each service. Hymnals, should you be comfortable using them, can be picked up when you come in and returned as you head out. They will then sit for one full week before we bring them back into rotation. We will continue to print the words for hymns/music in our worship folders.
- *Regular Worship Times*: Beginning next week, our regular worship times will resume. That's Saturday at 6:30pm and Sundays at 7:45am and 10:15am. Wednesday Lenten Services (3:30pm & 6:30pm) also begin on Ash Wednesday (Feb. 17). This will keep Pastors preaching schedule at 3 days per week instead of increasing it to four.
- Congregational E-mail Blasts: These will still go out each week with links to service folders, bulletins, and all other printed media as before. However, without the Thursday service we will no longer have the prerecorded option for that blast. A link to the live stream which becomes a recording after the service time will still be available just at the Sunday 10:15am time.

The council will continue to monitor all mandates and recommendations which come to us from local, state, and federal governments and attempt to keep the best interests of our congregational members and their health (physical, mental, and spiritual) in mind as we navigate these strange days.

In every change that comes, we remain steadfast in the Word of our God even as we place our trust in our Savior who told His disciples, "I have told you these things, so that in me you may have peace. In this world you will have trouble. But take heart! I have overcome the world. (John 16:13)"
