God's Word this week: Pentecost 8

This week, the emphasis in the readings begins to shift. The past eight weeks, the emphasis has been on the creation of faith and its preservation in spite of the evidence of suffering and persecution that seemed to contradict God's promise. Now, the second cycle of the Pentecost season begins, and with it an emphasis on the response of those who hear the Word. The response emphasized this week is: Those who have the Savior in His Word shared Him by sharing the Word.
