We talk about sweets "tempting us" and offers to spend a weekend away with friends when we really have to get things done around the house present a "tempting offer". However, the temptations of our sinful flesh, a sin-sick world, and satan himself are far more dangerous than a few extra calories or a missed opportunity to get chores done around the house. Each misdeed would drag us to the hellish abode designed for the devil and his evil angels. So we pray to our God that He keep them away from us and provide us the needed strength to resist them when they do cross our paths in this life.

Stewardship Thought comments on 2 Corinthians 9:7

For one thing, they could not ignore the responsibility which that freedom gave them. They were responsible for planning their giving. Secondly, they need to be aware that this planning process would be aided by the new man living in them, but it would also be obstructed by the old man. The Corinthians had the responsibility of making sure that they knew who was talking and of listening to the right voice.
