THE LORD'S PRAYER:

This summer, we are contemplating the Lord's Prayer. As we work through the nine parts of the Lord's Prayer (Address, 7 Petitions, & Doxology), we pray the Lord will increase our love for this prayer and His work within our hearts and throughout the world as well.

Want an even deeper dive? Follow along in Luther's Small Catechism. Consider reading a small section (question) each night for a devotional approach to continued study. The Fourth Petition is on pages 267-272 in the new deep blue catechism.

THE 4TH PETITION: GIVE US THIS DAY OUR DAILY BREAD

How many petitions in the Lord's Prayer deal with the spiritual? (6) How many are concerned with the physical? (1) What lesson can be learned simply by noting that imbalance with the petitions that our Savior offers to our Father in Heaven?

While it may be abundantly clear that the spiritual is the greater of the two, this is not to say the physical is unimportant, nor that it can never be a factor in our lives today. So, Jesus devotes time to our physical needs and the manifold blessings of the first article of the Apostles' Creed as the Father so willingly pours out blessings on His people.

Ah, but even here there are deeper lessons. "Daily" would war against the greediness which would overtake us even as it has overtaken our world. Pastor Lauersdorf wrote, "Often we turn the word 'bread' into 'cake', and when God gives 'cake,' we even ask for thicker frosting." May we war against the selfish sin of greed and once more rejoice in the forgiveness of our God who gives it more abundantly even than the physical blessings He pours out on us daily.

I once saw a plague with the following inscription: "What you have is God's gift to you. What you do with what you have is your gift to God." "What I do with what God has given me" – those words are a good working definition of stewardship. The word steward actually means "manager." In the Bible, a steward is someone who manages a household for an owner, often while the owner is gone. My stewardship, then, is my management of what God in Heaven has given me on earth. ...

Stewardship is an especially practical matter for the Christian. We Christians are not at all like unbelievers. We know the God who has given us what we have. We know the Savior who bought us with his blood. Because we are Christians, we have a desire to serve our Lord and Savior with all that we have.
