God's Word This Week: Summer Series: Apostles Creed

THE FIRST ARTICLE: PROTECTION

As we study the Apostles' Creed, we will have the opportunity to rejoice in the Gospel message, the good news of what our Triune God has done and continues to do for us, His Church here on earth. Each section of the Creed will then highlight one of the Persons of the Holy Trinity and their ongoing work on our behalf.

OSHA (Occupational Safety and Health Administration) was enacted in 1970. Even with a budget that checks in at over \$590 million, 4.5 million workplace injuries requiring medical attention occurred last year. Martin Luther wrote *God also preserves me by defending me against all danger, guarding and protecting me from all evil*. Our God actively protects us each day from threats far greater and of eternal consequence simply because He is our good and merciful Father.
