Last Week's Offerings:

As we continued our Lenten journey with repentant hearts, we presented the following thank offerings: Current – \$11,272.89; Missions – \$2,986.41; Improvement – \$110; Mortgage - \$1,653.75; Lenten Envelopes - \$1,016; Atar Fund - \$5; St. Paul's Student Aid - \$5; Organ/Piano Fund – \$100; Gym Improvement Fund - \$150 (Electronic funds included in these gifts - \$5,831.05; all offerings totaled \$17,299.05; Weekly target \$17,063). 105 people attended Midweek Lenten Services (62, 43, livestream = 50) 278 people attended regular weekend services (103, 75, 100, livestream = 39).
