## **WInGS Called Worker Training Endowment Fund**

A generous gift was given by Joel & Vicki White in honor of faithful Christian Mothers to begin an endowment fund to assist in the training of those seeking to become called workers within our synod. \$1000 has been placed in an endowment fund through the Fond du Lac Foundation. Once \$10,000 accumulates in the fund \$400 will be available each year into perpetuity for those seeking to continue their college education or higher at a worker training institution. Once the fund reaches \$25,000, \$1,000 will be available each year into perpetuity. The fund will be disbursed each year by the WInGS group here at St. Paul's. It will first be offered to those students of St. Paul's who seek to train to become called workers. If no St. Paul's student is available that year, the money will be made available at the request of area pastors to a student in the area who would benefit from the grant. *If you would like to donate to the fund to help it reach it's first goal of \$10,000 faster, make a gift for the endowment to the WInGS group who will deposit the funds with the Fond du Lac Association.*
