Please consider/reconsider serving on a Board here at St. Paul's

In the coming weeks (perhaps it has happened already) your phone may ring. It's time for St. Paul's to fill our various outgoing positions on the boards within our congregation. Please do not take these calls lightly but see them as they are, the Lord of the Church seeking to utilize your talents at this time in our congregation's history for the good of His larger kingdom. Just like our pastors and teachers, these are calls (yes, limited in scope and duration) extended by God through the congregation to you because they see the talents and abilities within you which can be of benefit to your fellow believers. Following is a slightly condensed listing of board duties from our congregation's By-Laws. We vote October 31.

Trustees (looking for 1 member – 2+ for a proper vote)

The Board of Trustees shall ... administer under and upon the instruction of the voters' assembly the real and personal property of the corporate congregation, consisting of real estate, buildings and their equipment, monies, securities, documents, and other things of value. The trustees are empowered to enter into contract, sign documents or other writings for and in the name of the corporate congregation, only after such transaction has been approved and authorized by the voters' assembly.

Elders (looking for 1 member – 2+ for a proper vote)

The Board of Elders together with the pastor(s) shall consult concerning the spiritual state of the congregation, giving attention to such matters as church and communion attendance, discipline cases, the congregation's participation in the Lord's work locally and in the church-at-large, and the congregation's outreach efforts in the community. They shall safeguard the preaching and teaching of the pure Word of God in the public services of the congregation and in its educational agencies. *For this reason, this board in particular will seek spiritually mature men (not necessarily aged) to serve.*

Christian Education (looking for 2 members – 3+ for a proper vote)

The Board of Christian Education, should the congregation elect to have such a board, shall consist of six men who, together with the designated pastor, shall have charge of the educational agencies of the congregation (Elementary School, Sunday School, Vacation Bible School, Adult Bible Study, etc.).

Board of Properties (looking for 1 member – 2+ for a proper vote)

The Board of Properties shall consist of three men. The chairmen of the Board of Properties will serve on the Church Council and act as its vice-chairman. ... The Board of Properties shall be responsible for maintaining the physical property of the congregation.

Where do my offerings go? Special Funds (part 5 of 5)

Special Funds have been designated for a variety of other items: Altar Fund, Audio/Visual Ministry, Choir Fund, Church Computer Fund, Hymnal Fund, Organ/Piano Fund, WInGS Tuition Assistance Fund, Worship at the Cross, SPLS Tuition Assistance Fund, SPLS Wishlist Fund, School Computer Fund,

Playground Fund, Gym Improvement Fund, WLA Tuition Assistance Fund, WLA Building Fund. A full listing of funds with explanations of all they do is not possible within the bulletin but a list of Funds is available in the tract rack by the information centers.
