The “*Giving Plus*” app is being retired at the end of this month. In its place, Vanco is offering “*Vanco Mobile*”. It should be available in your phone's app store. You may need to search for “North Fond du Lac” or “Fond du Lac” to find the church or the school accounts. *To make sure that the apps don't double-dip during the transition, please cancel payment in “Giving Plus” as you transition to “Vanco Mobile” and restart your offerings/tuition in the new app.* Remember, the Church account is for Offerings and the School account is for Tuition.

Where do my offerings go? Improvement (part 4 of 5)
